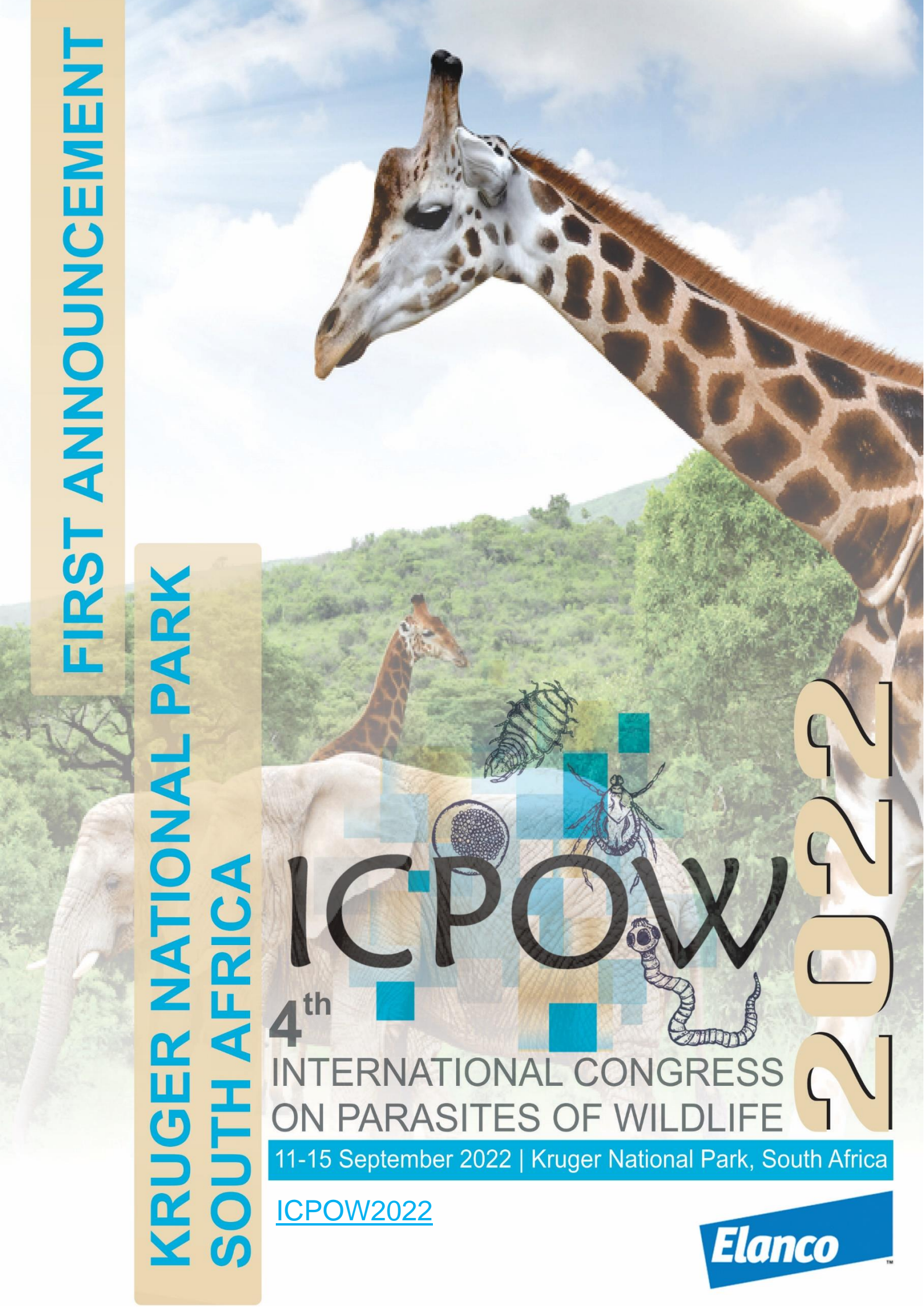

- If you have submitted an abstract for the 2020/2021 Congress, you are welcome to **resubmit** the same abstract; or submit an **updated** abstract; or submit a **new** abstract for the 2022 Congress.

- Please submit your abstracts, on the online platform.
- The deadline for abstract submissions is **11 March 2022**.
- Abstracts can be submitted for consideration either as oral or poster presentations. Please adhere to the instructions on the form.
- Delegates wishing to submit more than one abstract must please complete a separate form for each abstract.
- Abstracts are limited to 250 words.
- Include 3-5 keywords.
- Please ensure that the e-mail addresses as submitted are correct as these addresses will be used in all correspondence and acceptance notifications.
- Late submissions will not be considered.
- Oral presentations will be allocated 10 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions.
- Poster sessions form an integral part of the congress, and posters will be displayed on poster boards for the duration of the congress. Poster presenters are requested to stand at their posters during tea breaks.
- Poster Size: A0 - 841mm(w) x 1189mm(h).

Delegates are welcome to propose and develop a session theme that will form part of the conference programme. ACCOMMODATION
